**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04
Series of 2020**

**AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE DUPAX DEL NORTE MUNICIPAL INCIDENT
COMMAND SYSTEM AND ITS TEAM FOR THE IN-SCENE DISASTER
RESPONSE ON THE CURRENT PREVALENCE OF COVID-19 CRISIS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15, Article 2 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution Section 465 in relation to Section 16 of Republic Act 7160 which is known as the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Local Chief Executive to carry out measures for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;

WHEREAS, according to the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Memorandum No. 27 Series of 2020 which calls for the operational of the regional and local DRRMCs using the usual response mechanisms such as management of Emergency Operations Center (EOC), activation of Response Clusters and implementation of the incident Command System;

WHEREAS, clusters shall submit to the Dupax del Norte Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) as secretariat of the Task Force their Cluster Reports which include the task of each member, and coordination protocol among them;

WHEREAS, the LGU shall organize a 24/7 Incident Command System that will collaborate with the Dupax del Norte Municipal Task Force against COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE, I, TIMOTHY JOSEPH E. CAYTON, Local Chief Executive of Dupax del Norte, Nueva Vizcaya, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby decree the organization of Dupax del Norte Municipal Incident Command System and its Team for the in-scene disaster response on the current prevalence of COVID-19 crisis.

Section 1. Composition. The Taskforce shall be composed, to wit:

Section 3. Functions and Responsibilities. All Duties and responsibilities stated under Executive Order No. 03 Series of 2020 not in contrary herewith shall remain in force to include additional responsibilities required by the National Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases including those that are necessary for the proper execution of all protocols and models against the spread of COVID-19.

Each department, office, division, and agency of this Municipality is hereby required, to the extent not inconsistent with law, to cooperate fully with the Incident Command System of Dupax del Norte within the limits of its statutory authority and to furnish the task force with such assistance on a timely basis as is necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Order.

Section 4. Funding. Funding for the Operations of the Incident Command System shall be sourced from the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (MDRRMF).

Section 5. Separability Clause. Should any provision of this Order be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions unaffected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All issuances, orders, rules and regulations, or part thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
